This meeting was called to order as a Executive Committee Meeting (no quorum)

1. HW Thomas addresses a number of issues:

- Brings up the Avalon Bay property and says that it does not qualify for the zoning treatment they are asking for, and asked us what our position was on the development.
- Brought up the Volunteer Firemen's opposition to the ambulance fee.
- He is on City's Traffic and Transportation Committee.
- States that the MARC line will come to White Flint.
- Talked about traffic issues at certain spots, such as Edmonston and Twinbrook Parkway.
- Commented on the level of thefts and break-ins at King Farm.
- Discussed progress in filling Rockville Town Square.
- Urges us to take a ride with the police one night.
- Discussed Town Center economics & beauty, etc.

Carol Hannaford wants a digital timer crosswalk sign at Atlantic and Veirs Mill, and to raise the time to 36 seconds.

There will be a pedestrian overpass over Veirs Mill near Aspen Hill.

2. Vision for Rockville

We discussed the economic situation.

Dr. Wilcox advocated his vision for Rockville, supporting cost effective retail establishments as supporting Rockville's strength as a place to live and the ethic of frugality, and disliking the design of the Library as being in bad taste since it uses excess construction cost to impress. Bill Nichols opposed Dr. Wilcox's positions, saying that a lot of people who are vastly more intelligent than him disagree.
